

RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE PICKUP RECYCLABLES

- **Newspapers**
- **Magazines**
- **Catalogs**
- **Phone Books**
- **Junk Mail**
- **Office/Computer/Writing Paper**
- **Pressed Cardboard, such as cereal boxes, soda cases, etc.**
(combine all the above, place in brown paper bags or tied with twine)
- **Glass Bottles & Jars** (clear, brown, or green glass containers, no window glass, broken dishes, etc.)
- **Aluminum, Steel, Bi-metal and Tin Cans**
- **Plastic Bottles and Containers**
(McCullough/Waste Management customers - Stamped #1 & #2)
(Allied Waste/Leck customers – Stamped #1 thru #7)
- **Corrugated Cardboard** (must be flattened, no larger than approximately 2 ft by 2 ft)

COMMERCIAL BUSINESS AND OFFICE RECYCLABLES

- **Office/Computer/Writing Paper**
- **Newspapers/Magazines/Catalogs**
- **Junk Mail**
(Place all the above in a clear plastic bag)
- **Glass Bottles & Jars** (clear, brown, or green glass containers, no window glass, broken dishes, etc.)
- **Aluminum, Steel, Bi-metal and Tin Cans**
- **Plastic Bottles and Containers** (Stamped #1 or #2)
- **Corrugated Cardboard**
