

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Public Meeting Summary

January 21, 2009

At its public meeting of Wednesday, January 21, 2009, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Moved to keep the trash hauling program in the Township as it is;
2. Approved minutes of the December 9, 2008, special meeting, the December 17, 2008, regular public meeting and the January 5, 2009, organizational meeting;
3. Approved Resolution No. 2183 renaming to "Robert Sugarman Way" that portion of Big Oak Road west of Oxford Valley Road to the Middletown Township Line;
4. Acknowledged the request by Dave Ferri have Tax Parcel No. 20-009-003, 173 Mt. Eyre Road, included the Lower Makefield Township Agricultural Security Area;
5. Approved Ordinance No. 373 establishing an Amateur Radio Facility Overlay District;
6. Approved January 5 and 19, 2009, Warrant Lists and December, 2008, payroll;
7. Approved resolution No. 2181 authorizing destruction of certain specific records;
8. Approved Resolution No. 2182 authorizing the Township Manager to periodically invest Township funds to diversify exposure and reduce the risk of potential investment losses;
9. Approved Conditional Use Application by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless to increase the size of its existing telecom compound on Stony Hill Road;
10. Tabled request by Pennsbury School District for relief from permit fees for renovation project at Makefield Elementary School;
11. Granted an extension of time to April 21, 2009, to Norman and Patricia O'Rourke Minor Subdivision on Washington Crossing Road;
12. Granted a Certificate of Appropriateness for repairs and painting of the detached carriage house located at 1761 Yardley-Langhorne Road;

13. Moved to leave the following matters to the Zoning Hearing Board:
 - a. Michael Scott and Maura Beede, 1028 Lafayette Drive, request variance to construct an addition resulting in greater than permitted impervious surface
 - b. JAM Enterprise requests a variance to construct a handicapped access to a house located at 400 Collins Grant Court which would result in encroachment into special side, front and rear setbacks
 - c. Gary McClister, 506 Stony Hill Road, requests a variance to permit a 3 foot setback from the rear property line for an existing detached garage
14. Approved Resolution No. 2179 applying for Timothy U'Selis to attend a Police Officer Basic Training Program;
15. Approved Resolution No. 2180 applying for Brian Holder to attend a Police Officer Basic Training Program;
16. Appointed Birdsall Engineering as Township's Environmental Engineers for the year 2009;
17. Appointed Gilmore Associates, Inc. as Township Sewer and Conflict Engineers for the year 2009;
18. Reappointed Chip Kern to the Golf Committee;
19. Appointed Daniel McLaughlin to Farmland Preservation, Inc.
