Public Meeting Summary

April 15, 2009

At its public meeting of Wednesday, April 15, 2009, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Approved minutes of the April 1, 2009, public meeting as amended;
2. Announced Lower Makefield Township being awarded a 2009 Governor's Award for Environmental Excellence;
3. Awarded a one-year deer management contract for White Buffalo to conduct a sharp shoot;
4. Approved Resolution No. 2189 authorizing application to the PA DCNR for grant funds to be used for improvement projects at Memorial Park;
