

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Public Meeting Summary
October 6, 2010

At its regular public meeting of Wednesday, October 6, 2010, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Announced that Lower Makefield Township earned first place as Bucks Beautiful Community Garden;
2. Approved minutes from the September 15, 2010, public meeting as written;
3. Discussed an amendment to O/R District height restrictions, will place on October 17 agenda for further consideration;
4. Authorized advertising a revision to the Holding Tank Permit Ordinance;
5. Discussed cell tower ordinance, will discuss further November 3;
6. Discussed the Land Development application process, will review further;
7. Granted Certificates of Appropriateness for replacement signs at the Wachovia Bank on Heacock Road and the Wachovia Bank on Stony Hill Road;
8. Approved an extension of time to January 15, 2011, for the Gatherings at Yardley (Scott Tract) Subdivision;
9. Discussed Harmony Lane a/k/a/ Dogwood Drive project;
10. Moved to leave the Brown/Angrove ZHB request to the Zoning Hearing Board;
11. Awarded bid for 2010-2011 Salt Bid to International Salt Company, LLC through the Bucks County Consortium;;
12. Approved easements for the Black Rock Road Pedestrian Connector.
