The CTC members shared ideas and agreed to give more thought to the matter and discuss further at the April meeting.

Updates

Traffic Calming Guidelines

It was agreed that a section on frequently asked questions should be added to the Traffic Calming Guidelines. The Township Traffic Engineer has provided a list of possible FAQ's and Mrs. Torbert and Mrs. Herman will review and edit them.

Fairway Drive

Mrs. Torbert has reported the cut-through/speeding issue to LMT Police and requested enhanced enforcement. There had been consideration given to using the Traffic Calming Guidelines, but since they are not yet finalized, it was decided to request additional enforcement.

Stop at Bluestone and Roelofs

The CTC has received complaints that some drivers are not obeying the stop sign at the intersection of Bluestone and Roelofs Roads. CTC members will visit the site and report their findings at the April meeting.

Other Business

There was discussion of the Scudder Falls Bridge Improvement Project, which seems to be on track for final design approval. There was also discussion about preparations for the Car Seat Checkup Event on May 16th.

With no further business to discuss, the March 16, 2015 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was adjourned. The next meeting of the CTC will be held on April 21, at 7:30PM, at the LMT municipal building.
